

III. Academic Achievement

2022 Spring CAASPP (English Language Arts / Mathematics) & CAST (Science)



- In ELA, there is a shift from students *not meeting* the standards to *nearly meeting*, but there was a 2% decrease in *meeting* and *exceeding* combined; Distance from standard improved in English Language Arts.
- In Mathematics, there was a negative shift: *Met* and *Exceeded* decreased, while *Nearly Met* and *Not Met* increased
- In Science, there was a positive shift with 35% decrease in Not Met and an increase in Nearly Met (only 8th grade)
