Middle School Promotion Requirements

- Cumulative 2.0 GPA (1st and 2nd semester) in the following classes. Students cannot fail the same class both semesters.
 - English Language Arts
 - Pre-Algebra/Algebra I/Geometry
 - Physical Science
 - United States History
 - Physical Education
- No more than 2 "U's" per semester

• Satisfactory behavior, attendance, and punctuality.

• Serious behavior issues may result in revoking graduation privileges.

Summer School

Students who do not meet the required promotion expectations and fail core classes will be required to make up any failed classes during summer school, prior to being eligible to enter 9th grade.

Promotion Continued

- Participating in promotion Activities, such as grad night, promotion breakfast, and the final promotion ceremony itself is a privilege and not a right.
- Students must meet all promotion requirements, including satisfactory behavior, attendance and punctuality.
- These activities shall be held to recognize those students who have successfully completed board approved promotion requirements.
- Sth Grade Promotion meetings will <u>require</u> your attendance during each quarter.

COMMUNITY RULES

• Attendance – All students will be in attendance daily at 7:50 a.m. Both excused and unexcused absences must be cleared with a written note on the day student returns.

• **Tardies** – All students are expected to be in their seats, ready to learn, **before** the tardy bell rings *for each period*.
